

VOLUNTEER FACILITATOR APPLICATION 2026

Thank you for your interest in becoming a volunteer workshop facilitator with **Writers Collective of Canada (WCC)**! We currently provide virtual and on-site community writing workshops nationwide. Our current WCC Chapters include Toronto, Peel, Montreal, Ottawa, Vancouver and Lower Mainland, and Kelowna and the Okanagan.

We extend opportunity, dignity, and respect to everyone who wishes to write, celebrating authentic voice inclusive of race, ethnicity, class, age, gender identity, sexual orientation, physical ability, and mental health. Your participation will ignite voice, free unheard stories, and celebrate magnificent and undiscovered creative genius.

Our extensive training program will support your volunteer workshop facilitator journey.

We ask that all Facilitator candidates please:

- 1) Read <u>Why We Write: Ten Years at Writers Collective of Canada</u>, our latest chapbook that summarizes the impact of our WCC program.
- 2) Watch the WCC introductory video
- 3) Attend at least two (we hope more!) virtual workshops before training. Please review our calendar at www.wcc-cec.org/workshops for current public workshops.
- 4) Complete the full weekend of training. (This is mandatory).
- *We strongly encourage you to read **Writing Alone and with Others** by Pat Schneider. This invaluable resource provides the core values and structure of what we do. Pat Schneider was the founder of the Amherst Writers & Artists Method (AWA). Reading her book will enhance your training experience. Order online or through your local bookstore or library!
- *Listening to Shelley Lepp's (WCC's CEO) <u>Ellipses Thinking</u> podcast interview (less than an hour) will give you expanded insight into WCC's programming and its benefits.

To be certified, participants must attend the full training weekend (15 hours): FEB/MAR: Friday evening, Feb 27th, all day Saturday Feb 28th and Sunday Mar 1st, 2026. MAY: Friday evening, May 29th, all day Saturday and Sunday, May 30th and 31st, 2026. SEPT: Friday evening, Sept 18th, all day Saturday and Sunday, Sept 19th and 20th, 2026. Hours will be confirmed.

Post Training:

- 1) Attend a 1 to 2-hour orientation session covering online resources and workshop delivery.
- 2) Report on-site workshop attendance and stay connected with the Director of Volunteers and Programs and the Manager of Volunteers and Programs.





Because space is limited, preference will be given to those who have:

- 1. A commitment to and understanding of WCC's philosophy of creating a respectful and positive environment where people can write and share their stories.
- 2. Availability to facilitate workshops on-site in Toronto, Peel, Montreal, Ottawa, Vancouver and Lower Mainland, and Kelowna and the Okanagan.
- 3. Ties to the community/ies you are interested in working with.
- 4. A history of community engagement.
- 5. Experience with writing groups as a participant or facilitator.
- 6. Facilitation, leadership, or teaching experience.

After training, graduates will provide workshops for partner organizations, join an existing workshop series, or initiate a new workshop series through WCC staff. Co-facilitation is a best-practice at WCC. We will strive to pair you with a more experienced co-facilitator for your earliest workshops. A minimum commitment of 10 weeks (not necessarily consecutive) is required.
